Congratulations to all leaders and members of 3rd Stoneleigh Methodist Scout Group, celebrating the Group's 75th Anniversary today.

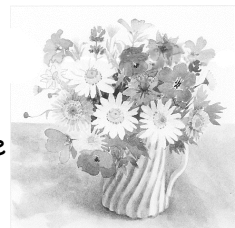
Thanks to the Brownies for their Good Turn cleaning effort recently, in and outside the church and thanks to those who helped to clean the remainder of our premises yesterday morning.
